

MTMT Mathematics Teacher Mini-Grant Application

The Middle Tennessee Mathematics Teachers (MT)² Association will award two mini-grants (~\$1,500 each) to inservice mathematics teachers annually at the MTMT Conference. Each mini-grant will support the purchase of either (a) ten TI-84+ calculators with the appropriate teacher presentation software, or (b) a classroom set of mathematics manipulatives (for 25 students).

Eligible teachers must teach mathematics in districts located in **Middle Tennessee**.¹ Recipients will be announced at the MTMT Conference; applicants must be in attendance at the conference to receive the award. Recipients are required to present a session at the MTMT Conference in year following the award to share “how they made use of the technology/manipulatives.”
